PUBLIC SAFETY NOTICE

Please note - it is your responsibility to look after your own safety whilst visiting the Keighley and District Agricultural Show - this Safety Notice has been designed to contribute towards your enjoyment during the Show.

1. Help prevent accidents by being alert to your surroundings
2. Remember that all animals/birds are unpredictable and can be dangerous
3. Ensure that when you cross over animal walkways extra care is taken and that you comply with the instructions issued by the Crossing Steward
4. Take care of your children
5. Keep push chairs & prams well away from large animals as they may adversely react
6. Be aware of moving machinery [plant & equipment] & moving vehicles
7. Do not walk in Animal Collecting Rings, Show Rings or Animal Walkways
8. Do not leave glass on the ground, place it in the receptacles provided
9. Do not light fires or discard cigarettes etc. until they are fully extinguished
10. Remember when reversing your cars, to do so with care
11. All dogs must be kept on a short, non-extendable lead at all times and be fully controlled
12. Co-operate with our stewards in cases of emergency
13. Keep a look out for obstructions that could cause you to slip or trip, such as Marquee Guy Ropes and uneven ground
14. Do not leave litter as it is a health hazard
15. Take note that there may be sudden noises that can frighten you and your dogs [bangs, loud music etc] so ensure you are prepared for these
16. When entering marquees, take note of safety notices and exit signs
17. Drink plenty of water to avoid dehydration
18. Take regular rests as necessary, especially if you are pregnant
19. Pregnant women; Persons without a Spleen; those that have had a Heart Transplant; and the Elderly should avoid contact with Farm & Equine Animals to avoid transfer of diseases
20. Be aware that there are a number of generators located around the Showground creating electricity therefore keep well away from this equipment
21. Wash your hands thoroughly before eating particularly if you have been in contact with animals
22. Consume alcohol responsibly
23. Listen carefully to public announcements and adhere to any instruction given out
24. Make yourself aware of the location of the First Aid Tent
25. Remember that Catering Units often have hot surfaces and can cause a burn or scald
26. In high winds, hazards such as dust and falling material could be evident
27. Apply effective sun block as required, wear appropriate clothing for the weather
28. Note that you are in the country and there may be additional pest activity e.g. wasps
29. Do not act in a manner that could cause an accident, such as unruly behaviour
30. Abusive or violent behaviour will not be tolerated and you will be removed from the Showground and refunds shall not be given
31. Missing Persons should attend/be directed to the First Aid tent
