- Class C28 **ANY OTHER** breed or cross breed Bullock
- Class C29 **ANY OTHER** breed or cross Heifer

### **YOUNG FARMER'S CATTLE**

**THE 1st KEIGHLEY CLUB CUP** for the Best Dairy Heifer in the Open Young Farmer's Classes  
**THE 2nd KEIGHLEY CLUB CUP** for the Best Beef Type Calf in the Open Young Farmers' Classes.  
**THE WORTH VALLEY YOUNG FARMER'S CUP** for the WYFCA member with most points in the YFC. Classes.

These classes are open to all cattle but must be shown by a member of a Young Farmer's Club. Young Farmers must have a current membership card available to present on show day.

Class C30 **DAIRY HEIFER**

Class C31 **BEEF TYPE BULLOCK OR HEIFER** (Subject to entries, this class may be split)

Class C32 **ANIMAL BEST PREPARED**, best handled for Show

### **FARMHOUSE CHOICE – CATTLE**

Class C33 **EXHIBITOR AND A BEAST OF THEIR CHOICE** - to be judged by a member of the public, in the Main Ring, before the Grand Parade

### **RULES APPLICABLE TO CATTLE SECTION ONLY** (in addition to the General Rules for All Exhibitors)

- 1 Movement restrictions in place on the 6<sup>th</sup> September **must** be adhered to by all exhibitors.
  - 2 All livestock trailers and vehicles must be clean and remain within the livestock section until they return home.
  - 3 All exhibitors and handlers must ensure their clothing and footwear is clean before they leave the livestock area. Disinfectant will be provided in appropriate areas.
  - 4 All exhibitors must have **Public Liability Insurance**
  - 5 All exhibitors are responsible for the safety of their animals which must remain in their allotted areas at all times.
  - 6 There will be no junior handlers of livestock
  - 7 In accordance with the H &SE guidance notes GS36 "Safe custody of Bulls at Agricultural Shows":
    - a. All Bulls must have two handlers.
    - b. All Bulls must be rung or led with nose grips
  - 8 All cattle eligible must be accompanied by a passport.
  - 9 All cattle must be registered with the Livestock Secretary before the start of the Show.
  - 10 Cattle to be in the Cattle Marquee by 10.00 am. Judging starts at 10.15 am.
  - 11 No animal to wear prize cards or rosettes during judging
  - 12 All livestock must remain on the field until 4.30 pm.
  - 13 Prize Winners will be expected to parade.
  - 14 In any class with 8 or more entries, a 4th Prize will be paid.
- Trophies to be held for one year and returned in advance of the following year's Show
